

Aquarium in Southern U.S. Housekeeping Services

This aquarium is home to more animals than any other aquarium in the world. With tens of millions of gallons of water the aquarium holds more than 50 exhibits.

ABM began work at the Aquarium in the Spring of 2011. With a staff of 45 full-time and part-time employees, ABM is on site 24 hours a day, seven days a week including holidays.

The aquarium is host to approximately 2.2 million visitors a year with 4,000 - 10,000 visitors daily. ABM employees work diligently to provide a clean environment for guests. From cleaning spills, wiping display glass on tanks and mopping splashed water in between dolphin shows, housekeeping at the aquarium is an ever changing challenge.

After the aquarium closes to the public each night, ABM begins a thorough night clean. In an effort to keep the environment as natural as possible for the marine life, the lights are set to dim as the sun sets and illuminate as the sun rises. Working by the light of head lamps, ABM employees complete a range of tasks including deep floor scrubbing, dusting, polishing glass, vacuuming and more each night to prepare the aquarium for the next days' guests.

Each day, salt from the tanks in the exhibit hosting the dolphin show evaporates into the air and settles on the 1,800 seats in the auditorium. ABM employees must wipe the salt from seats between all three shows.
